10 DAYS 9 NIGHTS ITENERARY USD4000 per person

This itinerary consists of 1 night Maun, 2 nights central Kalahari game reserve, 2 nights in Okavango delta, 2 nights Savuti and lastly 2 nights in Chobe for a minimum of 2 persons.

DAY 1-2 (2 NIGHTS CKGR)

You will be picked from Maun airport upon arrival and be transferred to a lodge in maun. By this time you can visit shops to ready your selves for tommrows journey to CKGR.

Day two

You will be picked up from the lodge and drive to central Kalahari game reserve, there will be some packed lunch and non alcoholic cold berverages on the way. This will not be just a straight journey, but will be a combo of game drive and admiring the flat grassland of the central Kalahari game reserve till arrival at the camp site.

The Central Kalahari Game Reserve is the largest, most remotely situated reserve in Southern Africa and the second largest wildlife reserve in the world, encompassing 52,800 sq. km. It is made up of salt pans, vast grasslands and acacia forests. There are dunes, but these are mostly vegetated dunes, rather than the kind of sand dunes you find in the Sahara. It is also famous for its ancient fossil river beds, which form valleys through the bush.

On arrival in CKGR game drive will continue and arrive at camp site at 1730. By this timethe backup team would have long set the camp site and ready to receive the guests onarrival.

Freshen up and famirilize yourself with the new environment

Have dinner and rest for the next day.

The term desert conjures up images of endless barren sand dunes, but the Kalahari is not like this at all. It is well vegetated in many places, with a wide variety of habitats and grasslands that stretch forever. Including tree savannah, sparse scrubland, mature forests and tall grasses tolerant to sandy soil, as well as a surprising number of lilies. To view all these mentioned, we have scheduled you an early morning game drive right after you have enjoyed breakfast. Having the breakfast during the drive is a considered option.

After the drive, lunch will be ready for you. Eat and rest. (by this time of rest you can take a warm shower before you embark on the afternoon game drive)

After you rest our professional guide will take you for afternoon game drive which will end at around 1800hr and then afterwards have dinner.

DAY 3-4 (1 NIGHT MAUN)

Good morning, we are going to our next location. SO right after our wonderful breakfast we head out for a short game drive and proceed out to Maun.

On this trip we will have packed lunch for us to stop by and enjoy.

Upon arrival in Maun, the driver will drop you off at the guest house where you will lodge for the night. The next day we will head out to another location.

DAY 4-6 (2 NIGHTS OKVANGO DELTA)

0830

Wake up freshen up and have breakfast, and a pick-up will follow from the guest house to the Okavango Delta.

The Okavango Delta is renowned for its tranquil, crystal clear water ways and papyrus-fringed channels. This is where the talented native people, well experienced in their well crafted traditional transport the ‘ mokoro’ take you on an unforgettable journey in the waters of Okavango delta. Okavango delta is home to wide variety of most sought-after bird species. In general its a bird watcher paradise with over 450 bird species recorded. Okavango delta also houses elephants, lions, buffalos, giraffes, hippos, crocodiles, and many species of antelope.

11:30

Arrival at the Delta, and you will be met and welcomed by professional polers who will transfer you to the campsite through a canoe (mokoro ride).

Upon arrival at the campsite, you will unpack your luggage and lunch will be already prepared by the Chef.

Enjoy lunch and rest for the afternoon activity of the day

After easing up, you will embark on a mokoro/ canoe excursion where you will enjoy more sightings of wild animals around the different pan handles of the Okavango Delta which will take approximately 3 hours.

Return back to camp, freshen up and enjoy dinner with traditional music and dance from the local polers and guides

Wake up Call at 05:30. Freshen your face up with warm water in the face wash basin. Yes breakfast is waiting for you.

Embark on a Safari nature walk on the vast stretches of untouched, unfenced wilderness and unrivalled game viewing.

After enjoying the safari walk head back to camp and engage with our guides for some traditional fun games followed by lunch.

After lunch, get ease for a mokoro ride later in the afternoon andGlide through a maze of clear channels and opaque lagoons on a traditionally-made mokoro, silently passing by unsuspecting wildlife and sparkling channels teem with fish and bird-life.

Have dinner and enjoy camp fire

DAY 6-8 (2 NIGHTS SAVUTI)

Next day, right after alarm call you will find warm water ready for you so you freshen up and have breakfast. After breakfast we start off our day with a game drive in the game reserve exiting the park proceeding to Savuti.

Chefs will have packed lunch, snacks, water & nonalcoholic beverages for you to indulge on, on our way to Savuti. This will be a journey with stop overs on the way and would take around 3 – 4hours to arrive in Savuti. On arrival in Savuti game drive continues until just before sun goes down. This is to make sure guests can be able to explore their new home in Savuti (The camp).

After freshening up, dinner will be called on of which the chef as normal would give a briefing about his cuisine. After dinner guests can then congregate around the camp fire and share folk tales with full company of the camp. The guide will give an account of the following day movement in Savuti. Savuti is a place of cheetah, wild dogs, lions and leopards and commonly known for leopards in hills and because of that a hill named leopard hill derives its name.

Day 2 in Savuti, we wake up early for an early morning game drive in the park along the Savuti channels with a packed brunch which we will enjoy at a stretching point while resting.

There after we continue with the game drive and head back to camp just in time for lunch.

After lunch guests can request for shower or just before afternoon game-drive they can request for shower. Our next activity will be afternoon game drive. For every afternoon game-drive guest have cold drinks and water with them in the fridge.

After game drive, have dinner and enjoy camp fire. Tomorrow we head to a different camp, so please make sure you are all packed and ready in the morning.

DAY 8-10 (2 NIGHTS CHOBE)

Tucked up in Botswanas far northern border with Namibia is Chobe National park- one of the greatest wildlife destinations of Africa. This is the only park known for its large herd of elephants in Africa and estimated to be over 120000. Chobe National park is approximately 11700 square kilometers and it is made up of rich ecosystems and prestine landscape consisting of savanna plains, river, swamp and scrub. Winding through this beautiful ecosystem is the magnificent mighty chobe river. The Chobe River flows lazily through the Caprivi flood plains and provides a haven for huge herds of buffalo and elephant, zebra, wildebeest and impala which are followed closely by predators including lion, hyena, the elusive leopard and the odd pack of the now rare wild dog. The bird life in particular is exceptional.

Let's leave Savuti for Chobe National park. Wake up early, you will find warm water in face wash basin, after this clients would take breakfast and take on a short game drive. With packed lunch guests will do short game drive and exit Savuti driving to Chobe national park. On arrival in Chobe national park guests with their guide will continue with the game drive and only arrive at the camping site in the late afternoon, then some dinner.

The bush chef has designed every meal according to your preference yet including his personal skillful touch and the culture of Botswana.

After dinner guests can then congregate around the camp fire and share folk tales with full company of the camp. The guide will give an account of the following day movement in Chobe national park.

Next day,

Good morning, let's explore Chobe National Park to its fullest by embarking on a game drive right after breakfast. This is going to be a different day. We will have packed lunch as we go out for game drive. We will then exit the park and drive out to Kasane to take a totally different activity, (The Boat Cruise) for three hours. After boat cruise you get back into your safari vehicle and continue the game drive as you close in to the camping site in the late afternoon.

Right in time for dinner and you last campfire with the team. Please make sure to pack your bags as we are approaching the end of the trip.

DAY 10 (DEPARTURE DAY)

Good morning, unfortunately today is your last day with us. You will find warm water ready for you to freshen up. Immediately after, leave your tents with your packed luggage on your way to have breakfast and while enjoying a full English breakfast, the camp hand will be packing up for us to leave.

As we exit our campsite, we will take a short game drive and there after head out to Kasane. We hope you enjoyed the trip with us!!
