MOBILE CAMPING AND VICFALLS.

7 NIGHTS 8 DAYS CAMPING ADVENTURE (USD3500)

6 days Mobile Safari Camping from Okavango delta (Moremi Khwai) and Chobe national park Savuti and Chobe national park riverfront). (1 night Maun, 1 night Moremi Khwai, 2 nights Savuti 2 nights Chobe national park)

PLEASE NOTE:

- A minimum 2 persons
- Guests arrival and pick up at appointed time.
- First and last night are inclusive in the itinerary

Day prior to the camping safari (complimentary accommodation in the guest house (1 NIGHT MAUN

Welcome to a 6 night, 7 day tour package itinerary. First you will be met by your assigned guide and then transferred to the guest house in Maun. There is not much to do on this day, but guests will have ample time to do shopping if necessary and rest depending on their time of arrival. In the late afternoon, one of our guides will brief you about your safari trip.

Day 1

Good morning, let's start with our camping experience. In the morning after you freshen up, a guide will be awaiting at the reception to help you check out and transit you to the Okavango delta (Moremi Game Reserve).

Ideally located in the central and eastern region of the Okavango Delta, moremi offers remote and secluded adventures in private concessions. Moremi is home to the Moremi Tongue and Chief's Island, featuring one of the most varied ecosystems in Africa. Witness the raw, untouched beauty of the open bush, widely acknowledged as the predator capital of the world. The region promises up-close views of unique wildlife and flourishing vegetation. What is expected there? Lions, leopard, wilddogs, hyena, well I can tell you Huge elephants as compared to other areas.

After an exciting drive to Moremi with packed lunch, you will then get on a game drive before heading to your first campsite.

Upon arrival you will be welcomed by camp staff who will then brief you about your new home in the bush. Freshen up and get ready for dinner.

A professional bush chef assigned for your tour will start dinner by explaining his menu of the day. Then after dinner campfire with the whole camping clan sharing experiences of life spiced with folklore tales.

Go to bed keeping in mind that you will be going to another campsite tomorrow.

Day 2

Next day, right after alarm call you will find warm water ready for you so you freshen up and have breakfast. After breakfast we start off our day with a game drive in the game reserve exiting the park proceeding to Savuti.

Chefs will have packed lunch, snacks, water & non alcoholic beverages for you to indulge on, on our way to Savuti. This will be a journey with stop overs on the way and would take around 3 – 4hours to arrive in Savuti. On arrival in Savuti game drive continues until just before sun goes down. This is to make sure guests can be able to explore their new home in Savuti(the camp).

After freshening up, dinner will be called on of which the chef as normal would give a briefing about his cuisine. After dinner guests can then congregate around the camp fire and share folk tales with full company of the camp. The guide will give an account of the following day movement in Savuti.

Savuti is a place of cheetah, wild dogs, lions and leopards and commonly known for leopards in hills and because of that a hill named leopard hill derives its name. Savute (or Savuti) is a remote corner of Chobe National Park renowned for its explosive big game viewing and notorious lion pride that take down adult elephants. Savuti is a totally different area with mixed landscape of hill, savanna and mash that attracts cheetahs because of its wide view area.

Day 3

In Savuti, you wake up early 0600- 1100 game drive in the park along the Savuti channels with a packed brunch which we will enjoy at a stretching point while resting.

There after you continue with the game drive and head back to camp just in time for lunch.

After lunch you can request for shower or just before afternoon game-drive. Our next activity will be afternoon game drive. For every afternoon game-drive you will have cold drinks and water in the fridge.

After afternoon game drive you will have dinner and enjoy camp fire. Tomorrow we head to a different camp, so please make sure luggage is well packed and ready in the morning.

Day4 (2 NIGHTS CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Let's leave Savuti for Chobe National park. Wake up early, you will find warm water in face wash basin, after this you will take breakfast and take on a short game drive. With packed lunch will do short game drive and exit Savuti driving to Chobe national park. On arrival in Chobe national park guests with their guide will continue with the game drive and only arrive at the camping site in the late afternoon for a shower, then some dinner.

Tucked up in Botswanas far northern border with Namibia is Chobe National park- one of the greatest wildlife destinations of Africa. This is the only park known for its large herd of elephants in Africa and estimated to be over 120000. Chobe National park is approximately 11700 square kilometers and it is made up of rich ecosystems and

prestine landscape consisting of savanna plains, river, swamp and scrub. Winding through this beautiful ecosystem is the magnificent mighty chobe river. The Chobe River flows lazily through the Caprivi flood plains and provides a haven for huge herds of buffalo and elephant, zebra, wildebeest and impala which are followed closely by predators including lion, hyena, the elusive leopard and the odd pack of the now rare wild dog. The bird life in particular is exceptional

The bush chef has designed every meal according to your preference yet including his personal skillful touch and the culture of Botswana.

After dinner guests can then congregate around the camp fire and share folk tales with full company of the camp. The guide will give an account of the following day movement in Chobe national park. Chobe national park hosts a largest elephant population in the whole world.

Day 5

Good morning, let's explore Chobe National Park to its fullest by embarking on a game drive right after breakfast. This is going to be a different day. We will have packed lunch as we go out for gamedrive. You will then exit the park and drive out to kasane to take a totally different activity.

(The Boat Cruise) for three hours. After boat cruise you get back in the game view vehicle and return to camp with game drive on the way.

Chef will call for dinner and explain his last dinner in the bush menu. Sadly this will be last night in the wilderness of Botswana national parks.

DAY6

Good morning, unfortunately today is your last day with us. You will find warm water ready for you to freshen up. Immediately after, leave your tents with your packed luggage on your way to have breakfast and while enjoying a full English breakfast, the camp hand man will be breaking up the camp.

As we exit our campsite, we will take a short game drive and there after head out to Botswana and Zimbabwe border for transfer to Zimbabwe vicfalls.

In Victoria falls

The highlight this time is the Zambezi sunset river cruise. This activity will offer a unique and intimate way to view the Zambezi river. You will be picked in the afternoon from your hotel and taken to the jetty to board the boat to set sail on one of the continents famous rivers.

The day will end with transfer back to the hotel after boat cruise. This will close the days activity being the dinner in the hotel.

Day 7

Good morning. You have well rested. Take a wonderful breakfast. The highlight of today is the guided tour of the falls. This morning after breakfast be ready to experience one of top greatest wonders of nature in the world, locally known as “ mosi- oa – thunya “. You will be transfered and experience the guided tour of Victoria falls.

Our safari ends immediately after finishing the tour of the falls.
