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NARE CAMPING ADVENTURE PACKAGE (USD400 per day per person)

9 DAYS 8 NIGHTS (Note: there will be a complimentary accommodation for 1 night prior the beginning of the camping safari)

Welcome, this is a mobile camping safari offering 2 nights Chobe national park (boat cruise in Chobe national park, game drives and home to largest population of elephants), 2 nights Savuti (leopards in the hills, lions, wild dogs), 2 nights Okavango delta Moremi Khwai (lots of birds, mokoro / canoeing in the Okavango delta, lions and wild dogs), 2nights Okavango delta Moremi Xakanaxa (lions, cheetah and leopard can be sported). Minimum 2 persons.

DAY 1-2 (2 NIGHTS CHOBE NATIONAL PARK)

Good morning, let's wake up early, freshen up, have breakfast at the guest house. You will find your driver ready to take you on your first activity of the trip being a boat cruise into the Chobe River.

. Tucked up in Botswanas far northern border with Namibia is Chobe National parkone of the greatest wildlife destinations of Africa. This is the only park known for its large herd of elephants in Africa and estimated to be over 120000. Established in 1968 Chobe National park is approximately 11700 square kilometers and it is made up of rich ecosystems and prestine landscape consisting of savanna plains, river, swamp and scrub. Winding through this beautiful ecosystem is the magnificent mighty chobe river. The Chobe River flows lazily through the Caprivi flood plains and provides a haven for huge herds of buffalo and elephant, zebra, wildebeest and impala which are followed closely by predators including lion, hyena, the elusive leopard and the odd pack of the now rare wild dog. The bird life in particular is exceptional

The luggage will remain with the guide on the time you will be in the boat cruise till afternoon. Guests will be picked by the guide and drive straight to the camping site in Chobe national park for their lunch. On arrival they will be received by camping staff who will introduce them to their new home in the wilderness. Freshen up and have lunch.

After lunch, you go on an afternoon game drive in The Majestic Chobe National Park driving the tracks and trails close to the riverbank, where you may have a chance to connect with nature and see as many species of wild animals.

Head back to the campsite, and freshen up for the evening

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Have dinner while enjoying traditional story telling from our beautiful guides.

Day 2

On this day, alarm call at 05:00hrs and freshen up, have breakfast and embark on early morning Game drive to enjoy more of the highlights of the Chobe National park.

After the game drive you head back to the camp for lunch. Eat, rest and by this time you may request for hot shower before the next activity being the afternoon game drive.

This will mark the end of the day when the sun begins to fade away which will then lead us back to the camp for dinner followed by camp fire.

DAY 3-5 (2 NIGHTS SAVUTI)

On the this day, you will rise up just before day break , pack your Luggage and emerge out of the tents and have breakfast.

After breakfast embark on the game drive vehicle with packed lunch and head out to savuti with exciting game drive on the way.

Savuti is a place of cheetah, wild dogs, lions and leopards and commonly known for leopards in hills and because of that a hill named leopard hill derives its name. Savute (or Savuti) is a remote corner of Chobe National Park renowned for its explosive big game viewing and notorious lion pride that take down adult elephants. Savuti is a totally different area with mixed landscape of hill, savanna and mash that attracts cheetahs because of its wide view area.

Upon arrival in savuti game drive will continue until arrival at the campsite which will be already set up by the Chef and the Camp hand man.

By this time the chef will be almost done with his tricks of pots in the fire to pave way for dinner.

Have dinner and enjoy story telling around born fire, and rest for the next day

Day 4

Wake up early morning for some breakfast. Shortly thereafter, you leave for a morning game drive through the beautiful landscapes of Savuti Marsh with some parked snacks.

Stop at the stretching point for a short break while having your snacks then continue with the game drive.

At the end of this educational drive, head back to camp where you'll find lunch ready. Eat and rest.

In the afternoon you embark on an afternoon game drive around the hilly terrain of savuti, getting a chance to catch the golden sunset silhouette appearing round the hills of savuti.

Head back to camp, freshen up.

Enjoy dinner and rest for the next day.

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DAY 5-7 (2 NIGHTS MOREMI GAME RESERVE - KHWAI -)

Day 5

Let's go to Khwai, but first wake up at 5am, freshen up and have breakfast

After breakfast you board your game drive vehicle and take the last lap of game drive in savuti and bid savuti bye bye as you drive to Khwai.

On arrival in Khwai game drive continues in khwai concession where you will experience more aquatic birds and large herds of animals. After gamedrive you will get to arrive at the camp site around 1630. This will give you time to freshen up or have shower before sun set.

The chef will give an alarm call that will gather you for delightful cuisine.

Day 6

Early morning, wake up early at 5 am for a quick shower then grab your packed breakfast for a 3 hour game drive in the game reserve.

Covering around 40 percent of the Okavango Delta, the Moremi Game Reserve is one of the great safari destinations in Botswana. Voted best game reserve in Africa in the past, Moremi was the first wildlife sanctuary to be created by an African tribe on their own lands. The Batawana people, concerned about wildlife depletion, are now stewards of Moremi, and many trips here will focus on Chief's Island, which was once a favored royal hunting ground. Ideally located in the central and eastern region of the Okavango Delta, moremi offers remote and secluded adventures in private concessions. Moremi features one of the most varied ecosystems in Africa. Witness the raw, untouched beauty of the open bush, widely acknowledged as the predator capital of the world. The region promises up-close views of unique wildlife and flourishing vegetation. What is expected there? Lions, leopard, wilddogs, hyena, well I can tell you Huge elephants as compared to other areas.

After this game drive head back to camp and rest while lunch is getting ready. Eat and siesta before your next activity being a late afternoon mokoro ride along the Okavango Delta channels.

Our professional guide will be waiting for you at the drop off when you finish the mokoro ride to take you back to camp where you will find dinner ready.

Freshen up, eat and listen to some story telling entertainment by our camp hand.

DAY 7 (2 NIGHTS MOREMI GAME RESERVE - XAKANAXAKA -)

0600- 0700 hrs. you will be woken up to the new day, leave your tents with your packed luggage bags then enjoy light breakfast. After breakfast leave the campsite with packed lunch and beverages and head to xakanaxa with game drive all the way to xakanaxa till arrival at camp site just before sunset..

Upon arrival camp hand will off load your luggage while the guide shows you around the campsite. After resting dinner will be ready and the chef will explains the tricks of his cuisine

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and after dinner you can gather with camping staff around camping fire and interact with sharing their stories.

Day 8

This morning we wake up, have breakfast and embark on the morning game drive vehicle. This is a totally different area with totally different landscape with water channels to be avoided. The morning game drive will go on till 11am and head back to camp to refresh and have lunch

After lunch you can rest and ask for hot shower before the afternoon game drive into the magnificent game country. Moremi Game Reserve is rated as one of Africa's finest game-viewing areas, take this opportunity to interact with our professional guide, ask questions and learn about wildlife, birdlife and vegetation found in these big lagoons.

Xakanaxa pronounced as Kakanaka lies on a pretty stretch of the reed fringed banks of the River channels of the Okavango delta. It is prime game viewing area.

Head back to camp after the afternoon game drive.

This is your last night here, so packing well on time will be ideal, but first let's have dinner.

After dinner rest early for tomorrow we head out of camp, we have reached the end of our trip.

Day 9

DEPARTURE TRIP

Unfortunately you have reached the end of you trip folks. You will wake up for a full English breakfast, freshen up and head out of camp to Maun. Drop off can be done at the airport or any location you prefer.
